Northeast Ski Resorts Offering Deals

Skiers: why fly out West this year with the flurry of ski deals being offered in the Northeast?

In Vermont, the Stoweflake Mountain Resort and Spa (www.stoweflake.com) is giving away a Stowe Points card to each guest who reserves an overnight stay before April 5. The card gathers points for various purchases and offers a \$59 lift ticket (normally \$89) every time cardholders ski Sunday through Friday at Stowe Mountain Resort, above. Nightly rates start at \$229 a room.

In Lenox, Mass., the Cranwell Resort, Spa and Golf Club (www.cranwell.com) is offering a two-night package that includes lodging for two adults and two children

under 12, breakfast, two lift tickets per adult, unlimited cross-country skiing on Cranwell's 10 kilometers of groomed trails, and a dinner. Rates start at \$369 per adult, double occupancy.

And in New York, the Whiteface Lodge (www.thewhitefacelodge.com) in Lake Placid is offering a package Sunday through Thursday that includes one free daily lift ticket to Whiteface Mountain for a one-bedroom suite. The number of tickets increases if a larger room is booked. Nightly rates start at \$250 for a one-bedroom suite with a kitchen (two-night minimum). Valid through April 2.
