Why Go:

I just returned from a week in the Adirondacks and where I was expecting mud and greyness, I was happily surprised by sunshine and great hiking conditions. The winter snow was noisily melting, rushing downstream and dripping from stony ledges, but the paths were dry and inviting. This protected state park, the largest in the U.S., is definitely worth a visit and the glorious [Whiteface Lodge](#) up in Lake Placid is a terrific place from which to explore. (Our editors describe it as a "rustic lodge featuring white-pine beams, cast-iron fireplaces, and well-equipped rooms (full kitchens; private patios) abutting the 6 million acre Adirondack Park.")

- › Overnight accommodations in a one-bedroom suite
- › Daily breakfast
- › \$50 resort credit for a 1-night stay; \$150 for a 2-night stay; and \$300 resort credit for a 3-night stay. Credits may be used at the restaurant, lounge, or spa
