THE WHITEFACE LODGE

This Adirondack-style facility, with its hardwood furniture, cast-iron gas fireplaces and rustic accents, is reminiscent of an old-world lodge with modern amenities. Families can take advantage of its spa, canoes, kayaks, boats, heated indoor-outdoor swimming pool, ice skating rink, 56-seat surround-sound theater and family game room with pool, shuffleboard, air hockey, foosball, 10-pin bowling alley, and nightly bonfire with s'mores. Recreational opportunities such as snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, hiking and mountain biking are available nearby. Lodge families have the option of enrolling their kids in Kamp Kanu, a nature-oriented skill-building program that teaches compass reading, campfire building and cooking, tent building, trail map reading, hiking, fishing, canoeing, swimming and kayaking at its private lakefront beach area.
